A MESSAGE FROM THE CHAIRMAN

DEBTORS – the amount of money owed by club players in Match Subscriptions, Disciplinary Fines and Annual subscriptions amounts to **over £700** in total. That means that we will have **£700 less** to pay for facilities, new footballs, new kits etc. for you for next season. If you owe money, can you please pay the money to your Captain or give it to me or if you want to pay by direct transfer into the Club Account, then please contact me.

PLAYERS WHO DO NOT PAY their debts will NOT BE SELECTED for next season unless or until they pay the debt in full. In addition, players who have not paid in full will **not be eligible to receive any awards** at the Club Dinner on 7 June 2013.

TEAM KITS – Unlike many Clubs, we supply full playing kits for all our teams, including shirts, shorts and socks. It is therefore most annoying when playing to find that the kit bag does not have enough shorts or socks for the whole team. I have had to replenish several kits this season, because shorts and socks have “gone missing”.
