

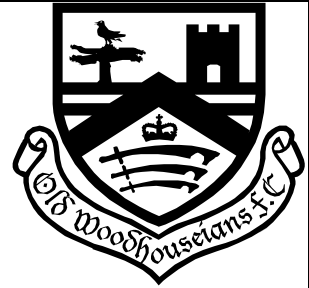

# DEBTS

From last season the Club is **owed nearly £700** in unpaid match subscriptions, annual subscriptions and disciplinary fines. This is totally unacceptable! We all need to pay our way to ensure that we can play football each Saturday – your subscriptions go towards ground rent, training, affiliation and cup entries, paying referees just to name a few things. David Goldring recently sent a letter to everyone who owes money from last season, so you should know if you owe the Club money. To be frank if the people who owe us money haven't paid up or at least started to make arrangements to pay **by 31 August** then they **WILL NOT BE SELECTED** to play for Old Woods until they have. The majority of people pay everything on time and we don't want to stop people playing for us but neither do we want people taking a free ride. # NEW GROUND!

Some of you may have heard some rumours about the Club moving to a new ground, especially if you're on Facebook or Twitter. Well they're true! Next season we'll have two pitches at [Old Camdenians sports ground](#) in Mill Hill. Most of you will have played there before against Camdenians but they've now folded and we are taking over the ground. Transport links are OK – Mill Hill East is within walking distance, Mill Hill Broadway (rail) is a short bus ride away and the 221 and 240 buses stop very close to the ground. One of the huge benefits about moving is that we'll have a Clubhouse on site not over five miles away from the ground which has been the case! The Clubhouse and changing rooms at Camdenians have been completely refurbished too with a fully stocked bar, Sky Sports and plasma screens so there is no excuse not to stay and socialise with your clubmates after matches. We'll be having more social events too, details to follow in a future newsletter.

We're also looking for a 'satellite' pitch close to Camdenians for when we have three home matches and we'll tell you once we've settled on one. Better facilities obviously mean higher costs so we'll be **increasing the Annual Subscriptions next season to £30**. This is a good move for the Club and we'll be moving back to the Borough of Barnet where we've generally always been based. # REPEAT SUBSTITUTIONS

At the League AGM Clubs voted in favour taking part in the FA's pilot on repeat substitutions for the 2012/13 season (all the Cups we enter are doing the same thing). It effectively means that every player in your squad of up to 14 is a potential substitute. So, if a player is substituted he becomes a substitute himself and can come back on the pitch for another player later on in the match. It's not complicated and is familiar to anyone who's played 5-aside, youth or veterans football and we also use repeat substitutes in friendlies.
