

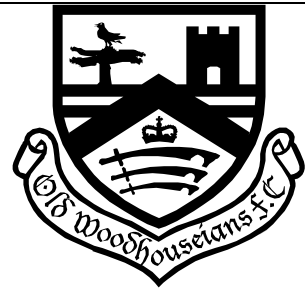

MONTHLY ROUND UP

The [1XI](#) have been knocked out of all the Cups and it's helped with their League form as they've pulled themselves out of the relegation zone with a great 3-1 win against Globe Rangers with only 10 men! A consistent side seems to be a problem but things are looking up. The [2XI](#) are still steamrolling ahead and have won five from five in Three North but are not top as they have games in hand. They're also in the LOB Cup and Wloch's men could be in contention for a League and Cup double. The [3XI](#) found November tough going with three defeats but one of those wasn't actually a defeat as Albanian fielded an ineligible player so the match will be replayed. Lack of a bona fide keeper has cost them in games they may have drawn or won – but with the players available they can challenge for promotion. Skipper Chris 'Stags' Achilles has turned things around for the [4XI](#) winning all their League games in November lifting them to fourth in Eight North but on equal points with the second placed side! Could they be on the crest of a promotion tidal wave?! BGR's [5XI](#) have hit a couple of speed bumps in their title charge losing to the other two sides who could win the League but they are still in the hunt. The fact two sides pulled out of games because of lack of players during November has not helped keep a winning rhythm. They're still in two Cups though – which is nice. The Vets40+ are in the Quarter Final of the AFA Cup and face a tough match against William Fitt on 8 December whereas the normal Vets knocked Globe Rangers out of the LOB Cup and face EBOGs in the next round as well as in the Old Boys Cup. Dave Goldring's Supervets (they're really old) had to postpone their friendly against Albanian due to lack of players. That is all.

Here they are and they make pretty good reading – our move to Camdenians has definitely had an impact on Organisation, Facilities and Hospitality but there is always room for improvement! SELECTION

There have been a few incidents of players refusing to play in the team they have been selected to play in e.g. not playing for a higher team when called up or a lower team when dropped. This is NOT how we run Old Woods – the best players play in the 1XI, the next best in the 2XI and so on. We are a CLUB not five separate teams, players are selected to play for the CLUB they don't choose where they play. This leads to playing over strength sides in lower divisions and it's no fun winning 8-0 every week! Furthermore, the league take a very dim view of Clubs that play squads and hold better players back and will withhold trophies, deduct points or fine Clubs if they suspect this is happening – see [rule 10e](#). If players refuse to play for the team they are selected in then they just **won't get game that week** nor further weeks unless they accept Selection Committee's selection – we've got plenty of players who are not getting a game at the minute so we are not short of players.

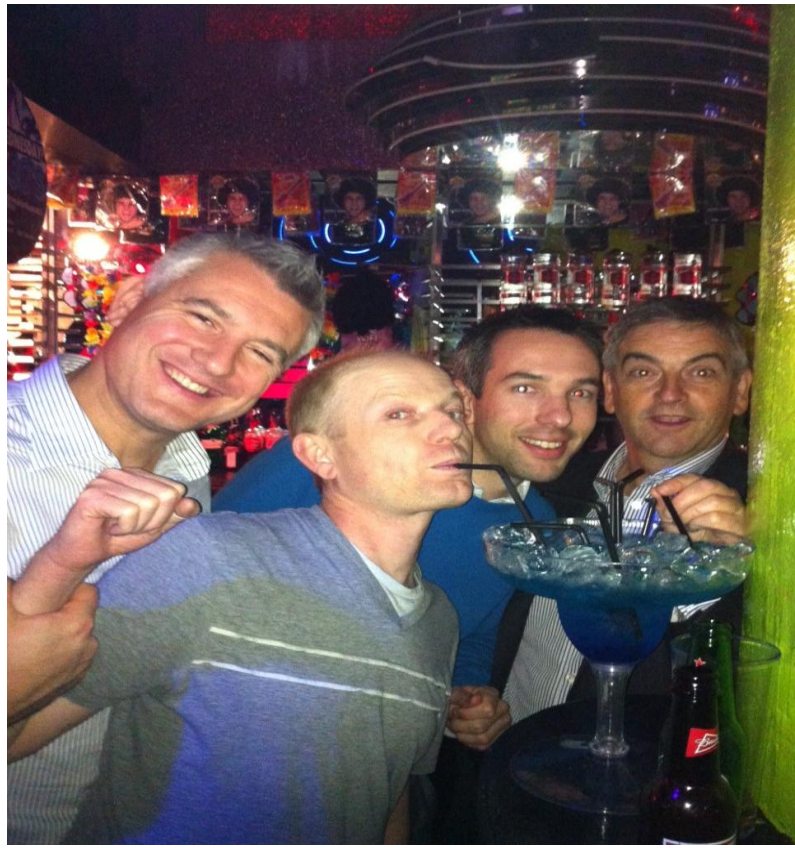
