Monthly round up

It's still been a bit tough going for the Old Woods sides in the 2011-12 season but it's still early doors as they say. The 1XI finally got their first points on the board with 1-1 draw with Pegasus on Saturday. The 2XI have had a string of tough Cup games against teams from three or four divisions above them — now they can concentrate on the League. Tim Worboy's 3XI have suffered from not having a settled side with lots of late cry-offs but have progressed to the second round of the Old Boys Cup after Old Bromleians withdrew. The 4XI are making steady progress and are currently mid-table. The bottom team also known as the 5XI are also mid-table in 10 North even though they've only amassed four points! The Vets were knocked out the AFA Cup by Winchmore Hill and the LOB Cup by Old Salvatorians but are still in the Old Boys Cup.

Discipline

It's pretty disappointing that we're having to write about disciplinary problems so early on in the season, but we are. Over the course of last season we (the Club) received 18 cautions and 2 sending offs. So far this season we've already had 16 bookings and 3 sending offs and it's only October. Simply put, this is **UNACCEPTABLE!** The County, the League and the Club will not tolerate indiscipline and persistent offenders will be banned from playing for Old Woods. Furthermore, every offence carries with it a fine – if these fines are not paid within **14 days** of the incident you will not be eligible to play until they have been paid in full – if you owe any money for discipline make sure you pay it to your Captain as soon as possible.
